Objectives

- Discover how to pass on passion
- Accept the idea that I am a leader
- Understand true servant leadership and the different ways it is expressed

Welcome

- Welcome people as they come in.
- As people come in, it's a great time to ask them how the daily study went and get a feel for how many of the group completed the study guide.

Relate

- Name someone you think of as an effective leader. What qualities does this person have that make him or her a great leader?

Remember

- In Kingdom life, who are called to be followers? Who are called to be leaders?
- "We all look like sheep from the front, but shepherds from the back." In your own words, what does this mean?
- Which of the learning stages (Happy Puppy, Toy Chihuahua, Golden Retriever, Pregnant Pooch) do you most identify with? Why?
- Which of Jesus leadership styles (directive, coaching, friendship, delegation) is the easiest for you to understand? Which is the hardest?

Reflect

- What do you think is the most important characteristic of a good leader?
- Who provides leadership to you in your life? How would you define that person's leadership style?
- Think about a time when you were invited in on the ground floor of something new. Discuss your early feelings about this new endeavor.
- Have you ever been the leader of a group launching something new? What was that experience like?
- How does having the big picture help you persevere when something is difficult?
- Share an example of a time when you were in a stage 3 environment. How did you feel?
- Have you ever moved from being a learner to being a leader? What were you learning. What was it like to make that transition?

Review

- Think about a few opportunities you have had to be a leader. How well do you think you fit that role?
- Think about a situation that you face this week. How can you apply the square to that situation. Jot down some ideas around the square.
