

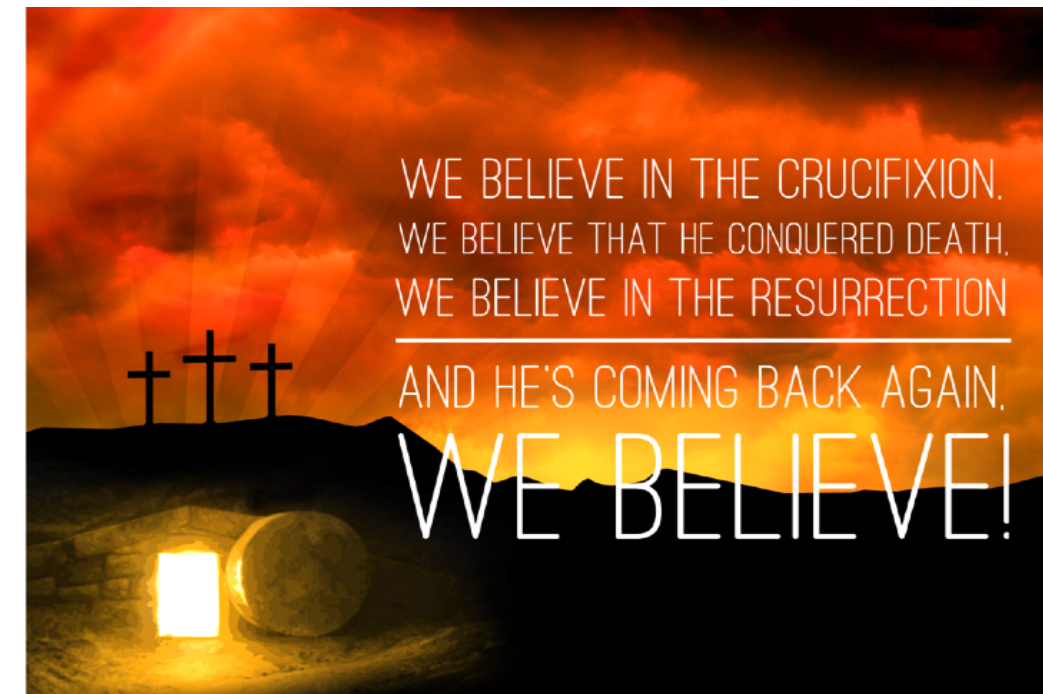


Praying for Each Other - We invite you to join us in prayer for our church and friends.
