ALICE PRESENTATION - Thursday, May 9, Dr Mills gave a presentation entitled "Preventive Medicine for ALICE" to the Kootenai County ALICE task force at the Idaho Department of Labor conference center in Post Falls. ALICE (Asset Limited Income Constrained Employed) is the subset of our population who are working families that are above the poverty level but can not cover all of their monthly living expenses. They comprise 26% of Kootenai County. The ALICE task force operates as a UNITED WAY organization. Dr Mills discussed how practicing preventive medicine could impact these families and gave recommendations. He is also a member of the task force.
