

PASTORAL SEARCH UPDATE - The pastoral search committee (PSC) has met the last two Thursdays. The first meeting was with Elder Rodney Mills (UCC). He asked the questions: How do you describe your church? What would you want a new pastor to know about your church. What are our church strengths and in what areas does this church need to grow?

Elder Mills has agreed that the we will present no less than 10 pastor names to them to vet. In addition to this, UCC says we may Zoom video interview 4 (instead of 3) candidates if there are four people who are willing that we would like to video interview.

Your PSC team has been doing as much research as possible this past couple of weeks on the over 40 names you submitted. This last Thursday we met to review our research and to begin to narrow it down to the 10 names we will offer to you as top candidates to consider. After 3 1/2 hours we have narrowed it down to just less than 30! All the names will come back to the church in business session to learn which 10 names came to the top, and why, and why the other names were taken off the list. The list will be voted on by the church. Be watching for dates on this upcoming all-church meeting. Our next PSC meeting will be next Thursday at 5:30pm.
