COMMON SENSE WAYS TO AVOID *any* VIRUS

- Avoid close contact with sick people.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, & mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Follow CDC's recommendations for using a face mask.
 - It is not recommended you wear face mask if you are well to protect yourself from respiratory diseases, including COVID-19.
 - Face masks should be used by people who show symptoms of COVID-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others and used by health workers
 - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 sec., especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
 - If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
