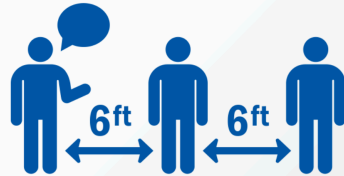

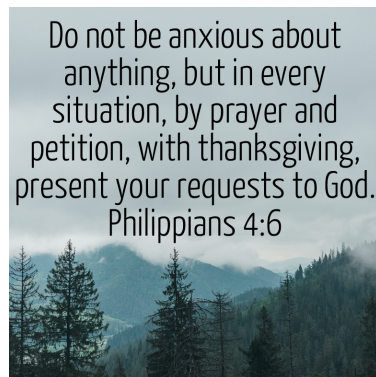

IN ORDER FOR US TO STAY OPEN - We each need to be vigilant in doing what we can to slow down the spread of Covid. We can do that by:

1. Wearing a face covering
2. Distancing at least six feet
3. Sanitizing hands
4. No hugs or handshakes

IF we learn that someone tests Covid positive in the week following the Sabbath they were in church worship, we will take the church service online only (church would be closed) for one Sabbath to provide a 13 day quarantine period and assess the risk in conjunction with Panhandle Health to determine if further steps are needed.

We rely on you to let us know as soon as possible if you experience symptoms after being in a church service so that we can act responsibly to curb the spread. Thank you.

If you are health compromised or in a high risk group, you may want to consider worshiping with us online or at home until we get out of the critical red zone, when our area Covid numbers have declined.
