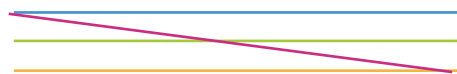

GENERAL CONFERENCE SESSION POSTPONED - For the second time in 10 months, members of the executive committee of the global Seventh-day Adventist Church have voted to postpone the quinquennial session of the denomination, originally scheduled for late June 2020, due to challenges arising from the COVID-19 pandemic.

IF YOU ARE LOOKING FOR CHILDCARE, please contact the church office. A couple have shared their name for you to consider.

IN ORDER FOR US TO STAY OPEN - We each need to be vigilant in doing what we can to slow down the spread of Covid. We can do that by:

1. Wearing a face covering
2. Distancing at least six feet
3. Sanitizing hands
4. No hugs or handshakes

IF we learn that someone tests Covid positive in the week following the Sabbath they were in church worship, we will take the church service online only (church would be closed) for one Sabbath.
