RETURNING TO ONE SERVICE - MARCH 13

Your CDA church board has been discussing Covid safety for months now - just like many of you have. We are anxious to return together for one service again. With our State going to stage three, a big drop in covid numbers, and vaccines now out for age 65 and older, we have decided to return to one service on March 13. This means that Sabbath Schools will open at 9:30am and our worship service will begin at 10:45am.

Our church family has been amazing at following the guidelines for masking and distancing. Thank you! Now that we will be opening (on the 13th) for one service, it is all the more important to mask and try to remain distanced as possible.

We will continue to live-stream our services. If you don't want to wear a mask, and/or if you feel a group setting is not safe for your health, we ask that you join us online for your worship experience.

IN ORDER FOR US TO STAY OPEN - We each need to be vigilant in doing what we can to slow down the spread of Covid. We can do that by:

- 1. Wearing a face covering
- 2. Distancing
- 3. Sanitizing hands
- 4. No hugs or handshakes

IF we learn that someone tests Covid positive in the week following the Sabbath they were in church worship, we will take the church service online only (church would be closed) for one Sabbath. Update: Once enough time has passed that most of our most vulnerable attenders will have had the opportunity to be vaccinated, we will not plan on shutting the church down following a positive Covid notification.

WE RELY ON YOU TO LET US KNOW as soon as possible if you experience symptoms after being in a church service so that we can act responsibly to curb the spread. Thank you.
