We just ask that you keep your gathering just to your family group. You can look forward to hot cider and cookies by Lana Brauer and Alissa Wallace.

* Dress warmly whether you plan to stay in the car or sit outside. We ask that you don't run your car engines during the program as we don't want the parking lot full of carbon monoxide nor the noise from the cars. So bring a blanket and enjoy the hot cider!

IN ORDER FOR US TO STAY OPEN - We each need to be vigilant in doing what we can to slow down the spread of Covid. We can do that by:
