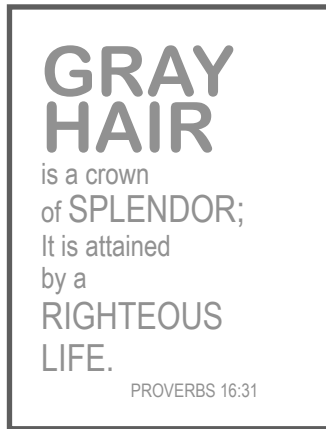

OFFERING APPEAL FOR TODAY - NAD Evangelism: The young lad told his mother the news. Jesus, the Miracle Worker, would preach by the Sea of Galilee that day. He wanted to see Jesus. His mother packed him a lunch. The boy didn't realize that what he had in his hand would touch the lives of thousands that day and for centuries to come. He arrived early and found a front-row seat. He never remembered his lunch until near evening. Then he heard the Master speaking to the disciples about a need for food. He offered Jesus all the food he had. Jesus thanked him and asked the multitude to sit down. He "took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude."
